

HOW TO TRANSFER YOUR NSITF CONTRIBUTIONS INTO YOUR RSA ACCOUNT

Did you know that your National Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) contributions can now be transferred into your Retirement savings accounts?

STEPS TO TRANSFER YOUR NSITF CONTRIBUTION TO YOUR RSA ACCOUNT

All employees are requested to:

- Obtain NSITF transfer application forms from your respective Pension Fund Administrators website or offices.
- Attach original NPF and or NSITF membership certificate
- Attach copy of your NPF OR NSITF membership certificate
 - Where the certificate is lost; a sworn court affidavit and letters of confirmation of identity and indemnity from the bank.
 - Where no certificate was issued; letters of confirmation of identity and indemnity only are required.
- Attach copy of your NPF or NSITF statement of account. This can be viewed and printed online from www.trustfundpensions.com
- Attach Copy of identification (Driver's License, International passport or National ID)
Where there has been change of name, attach certificate reflecting such change.

The above mentioned documents is to be submitted to your respective PFAs who will there after notify you when the transfer process is concluded.
